The information pertaining to important issues / developments in respect of the Department of Sports during the month of April, 2018 is as follows:

Performance in Commonwealth Games, 2018:

India competed at the 2018 Commonwealth Games held in Gold Coast, Australia from 04th to 15th April 2018. It was India's 18th appearance at the Commonwealth Games. With 26 Gold medals and a total of 66 medals (26 Gold, 20 Silver and 20 Bronze), India finished 3rd for the tournament. It was India's best position since the 2010 Commonwealth Games.

Good Governance and transparency in sports bodies / Coach Bank to Sportspersons:

Emphasizing transparency and good governance in sports bodies, Union Sports Minister said that government is committed to ensure 'clean sports' in a meeting with a delegation of International Olympic Committee (IOC), Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) and Indian Olympic Association (IOA) on 19th April, 2018. President of Indian Olympic Association assured the government of all support in matters of good governance, transparency and in implementing the sports code.
